Welcome back after the summer break. We hope you had an enjoyable August, however you spent your time.

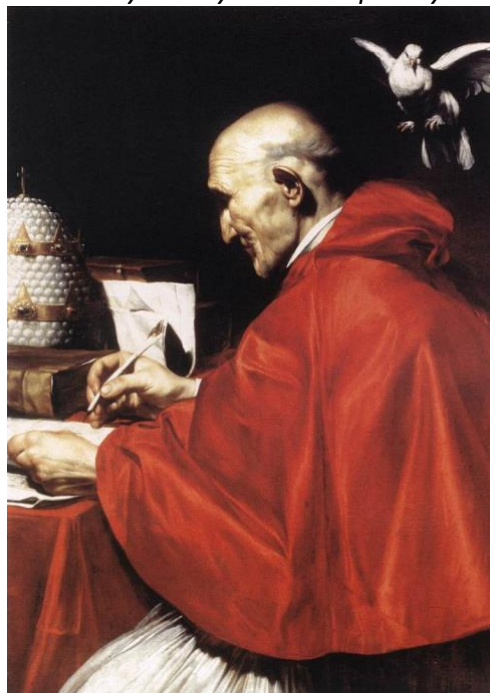
