Outcome of Council Meeting 1 October

Council passed the following resolutions:

"To commission repairs to the Wisteria wall, the south facing wall, the entrance hall and front door to be undertaken at an appropriate time in spring 2024, at a cost of €11.140 plus IVA".

"The Friends of All Saints' Fund be closed and the residual balance of €715 be transferred to the General Fund".

"The Chalice be henceforth reinstated during Eucharist as an option for all to receive Communion in two kinds."

"To approve the vacancy documentation for submission to the Archdeacon prior to the Vacancy Meeting."

Pledged giving cards

A majority of pledged givers donate by bonifico, transferring funds directly into the Church bank account. They do not give cash when the plate is passed around. This may cause individuals to feel uncomfortable – it appears to those around that they are not contributing, when the opposite is true. To address this issue, pledge giving cards are available at the entrance to the church. Simply take one and place it in the plate during the offertory hymn.
