Katharine Rumens, our new locum, introduces herself

Having trained to teach art in Norwich I decided life outside the UK was more interesting and lived in Madrid, Modena and Aveiro, Portugal teaching English to adults. I returned to London to do a fashion course, but as no-one would employ me, set up under the label Kate Rumens. For most of the 80s I designed pretty posh clothes while actively involved in my parish church and campaigning for women's ordination. After Westcott House, Cambridge I was a curate in East Ham. I was then part of the team in Waterloo where I was also chaplain to the South Bank Centre, the Old Vic Theatre and the then London Weekend Television studios. In 2000 I became Rector of St Giles' Cripplegate in the City of London. It was a fascinating parish with a residential population and included offices, schools, livery companies and the Barbican Arts Centre. I retired in 2021 and have returned to live in Salisbury where I grew up. I am very much looking forward to meeting the community of All Saints' in November.
