This Sunday we welcome the Rev'd Canon Michael Bullock who leads our Eucharist Service at 10.30, and will be with us over Advent and Epiphany.

8 December marks the Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The day celebrates Mary being conceived free from sin and stain, by her mother, St Anne and father, St Joachim. The tradition is a Roman Catholic one, generally not followed in Protestant doctrine, though some Anglo-Catholics hold the Immaculate Conception as an optional pious belief. Consequently, the day is a public holiday in Italy, but only recognised as a minor feast day in Anglicanism.



7 December is the Feast Day of St Ambrose, patron saint of Milan.
