The Council discussed the draft financial statements and the draft budget. The final versions of these will be submitted to Council for approval at the next meeting, on 18 February. The draft financials show a surplus for 2023, excluding disabled lavatory funding, in excess of €15.000. However, our budget for 2024 shows a projected deficit of €7.000, which we will need to close. The deficit is due to building costs we will incur this year, and recruitment and salary costs of our new priest. Both these documents will be presented at the AGM.

#### **Electoral roll revision**

The annual revision of the electoral roll is commencing and will close on 18 February, after our Council meeting on that date, and the Roll will then be frozen until after the AGM.
