## The birth of John the Baptist

John the Baptist's birth is celebrated on 24 June, three months after we celebrate the Annunciation.

John's birth is miraculous. His mother, Elizabeth, was considered too old to bear children, and John's birth is foretold to his father Zachariah by the archangel Gabriel, who also names the child. A disbelieving Zachariah, a temple priest, is struck dumb until the baby's birth.
